	 Choose a class service project for students to complete. Popular projectideas include:
	 cleaning up the school grounds
	 sorting objects for recycling
	 beautification projects like planting trees or gardens
	 straightening or organizing the library
	 creating artwork for common areas
	 organizing a book, toy, or school supply drive for a classroom or the library
	 reading to younger students (or buddying up with them for other tasks)

Background	Tell students that 9/11 Day is a national day of service, which means helping or doing things for other people.
	It is also a day of remembrance, when we honor the thousands of people who died in a series of events on September 11, 2001.
	Point out that after 9/11, people did kind things for each other and served their communities together.
