Goals	Participate in a class service project.

Materials	Journal: Class Service Project printable
Preparation	Print a copy of Journal: Class Service Project for each student.
Background	Tell students that 9/11 Day is a national day of service, which means helping or doing things for other people.
	It is also a day of remembrance, when we honor the thousands of people who died in a series of events on September 11, 2001.
	Point out that after September 11th, people didn't focus about their differences; they felt connected to one another. They did kind things for each other and served their communities together.
Introduction	If you completed Activity 6: Class Service Pledge, go to Activity.
	If you did not complete Activity 6: Class Service Pledge:
	 Tell the class that it is time for them to complete a school service project together.
	 Offer several suggestions for which students can choose to vote, such as ideas that benefit the following groups:
	\cdot a classroom of younger students (buddy projects)
	\cdot a new teacher in need of supplies (book and supply drives)
	 custodial and maintenance workers (grounds projects like cleanup and beautification)
	\cdot media center personnel (cleaning electronics and organizing books)
	\cdot all students and staff (creating artwork in common areas)
	Spend a few minutes as a class discussing the merits and difficulties of the choices you provided.
	Have students vote on the class service project.
Activity	Guide students through any necessary preparation for the service project.
	Depending on the project, this may involve any number of the following:
	\cdot making a list of steps necessary to complete the project
	 making a list of supplies
	 gathering needed supplies
	\cdot scheduling the event
	When preparation is complete, lead students through the steps in completing the selected service project.
