Preparation	If you did not complete Activity 7: Pledge to Serve, first:
	Prepare a list of a few service projects that connect in some way to the stories of the 9/11 Ambassadors.
	Have students vote on the best service project.
	If you did complete Activity 7: Pledge to Serve:
	Print a copy of Journal: Class Service Project for each student.
Background	In the days after 9/11, people across the country felt united by a desire to help and support one another, creating an extraordinary spirit of empathy and resilience.
	Many Americans stopped thinking about the differences that often separate us, at least for a while.
	For those who lived through the tragedy of 9/11, that time of caring and helpfulness remains an important reminder that we are stronger as people, and as a nation, when we work together
Introduction	Have students make any necessary preparations for their service project, guiding their process as needed.
	Depending on the project, this may involve any number of the following:
	\cdot making a list of steps necessary to complete the project
	 making a list of supplies
	\cdot gathering needed supplies
	\cdot scheduling the event
Activity	When preparation is complete, support students as they go through the steps in completing the selected service project.
	Have students take photos as they complete the service project.
	 Have students reflect on their experience with the service project by completing Journal: Class Service Project.
	As time allows, create a visual or electronic display of the pictures of the service project.
